

<u>Transnational Project Meeting in Maribor (Slovenia)</u>



The third meeting of the ERASMUS+ Train4Coordinators project partnership took place in Maribor, Slovenia, on 21st April.

The main objective of this in-person meeting was to finalise the training material that we have been developing. This material will soon be available on the dedicated online platform specifically designed for this purpose.

Furthermore, we have initiated the development of an online application that will allow coordinators to easily assess their competencies and identify areas for improvement.

Volunteer training management toolkit for volunteer coordinators

The training material focuses on enhancing the skills of volunteer coordinators in various areas, including communication, leadership, social media, public relations, volunteer management software, and monitoring and evaluation of volunteer programmes, among others.

This material will be conveniently accessible through the Train4Coordinators <u>Online Learning Platform</u> for Volunteer Coordinators. Its primary objective is to foster the development of knowledge, skills, and competence among coordinators while also raising awareness about the importance of volunteering.





Self-assessment app for competencies monitoring in volunteering

Partners have commenced developing an app to evaluate the competencies of youth workers, young volunteers, and youth coordinators in the field of volunteering.



Upon completion of the assessment, users will receive a badge as a recognition of their achievements. This badge can be used to demonstrate proficiency in self-planning, self-learning, and self-assessment in relation to volunteering activities.
